



## The Mentorship Program

Are you a professional looking to continue your career in Canada? Did you complete all or most of your education and work experience outside of Canada?

Consider applying for the Mentorship Program!

The Mentorship program is a free work-readiness program designed for newcomers who want to gain Canadian experience in their area of training and learn more about Canadian work culture. Applications for the Program are accepted all year and intakes are held in February, May, and September.

The Program consists of two major parts:

- 1) **An 8 week in-class portion** consisting of workshops on Canadian workplace culture, job search techniques, interview skills, and a variety of other employment-related topics.
- 2) **An 8-12 week work placement** in which participants complete a volunteer internship with a company involved in the client's area of training. Participants are able to gain Canadian work experience, demonstrate their skills to an employer, and network with other professionals in their field.

### Eligibility Requirements:

- Minimum CLB 5
- Permanent Residents, Refugees, Work Permit holders, and Canadian Citizens
- Have been in Canada for less than 5 years
- No age limit
- Be legally able to work in Canada, and currently unemployed or under-employed
- Must have completed post-secondary education (some or all education must have been completed outside of Canada)

- Work Placement at various locations across the city
